I love to see the Christmas decorations that people put in their yards and on their homes during this time of the year. Some people are very serious about their decorations and they start decorating right after Halloween, while others wait until the last minute. All of the preparations for Christmas serve as a reminder that something exciting is coming. The decorations,
