



"Love is patient, love is kind. Love does not envy, *it* does not boast, *it* is not proud. Love does not dishonor others, *it* is not self-seeking, *it* is not easily angered, *it* keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. Love always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres." – 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

February is often considered to be a month of love, with the celebration of Valentine's day. Therefore, the verses above describe the kind of love that I'm sure we would all like to receive. The challenge for us is to read these verses and realize this is the kind of love that Jesus gives to us and that we are called to give to others. One way that has always helped me to consider my limits of loving others is by checking my love score by reading the verses from 1 Corinthians 13 and substituting my name wherever the word "love" or "it" appears. Try it for yourself and see how you score.

I'm sure none of us will score 100% when we read those verses, but the good news is that our failures of the past have been forgiven, and today and tomorrow are full of new opportunities to raise our score. Following true love means following Jesus, being transformed by His love, and being committed to His mission of loving others in the way He loves us.

One of the ways we have put the love of Jesus into action has been through our generous financial donations to the Hurricane Helene relief efforts. Our congregation has contributed \$60,000 to Emergency RV, which has directly helped to provide shelter to 90 families in western North Carolina. In addition, our quilting ministry donated several quilts to the relief efforts and every quilt brought more than a few tears to the families who received them.



Opportunities to support the relief efforts will continue throughout the year, especially at our Lutheran camp in the mountains known as Camp Linn Haven.

Several members from our church have volunteered to help rebuild the camp as all of the cabins, along with the Mountainside Lutheran Church sanctuary, suffered tremendous damage. Two outside estimates indicate the recovery could be in the \$2 million range, which means many volunteers and donations will be needed throughout the year. However, we know with God nothing is impossible and He will lead us in our efforts to share His love with others in the western part of our state as communities and churches continue to recover from the hurricane damage. Thank you for all of your support.
