



#### DO YOU SEE GOD?

I always enjoy it when many of you ask me questions in Scripture that causes me to take a deeper look into God's Word in order to understand what He is telling us. Someone asked me recently about whether or not people could see God and live, based on Exodus 33:20 when God said to Moses, "But you cannot see my face, for no one may see me and live." In order to understand certain verses in the Bible many times we need to look at other parts of Scripture to fully understand what God is telling us.

Seeing

When God says that no one can see His face, what He is saying is that to see His face would be the same as seeing Him in His full glory. In Exodus 24 it says that Moses, Aaron, Nadab, Abihu, and the seventy elders of Israel saw the feet of God, but they did not see God's face - meaning they did not see the full glory of God. What's interesting is that someone's feet were often considered one of the lowliest parts of their body, and yet simply seeing God's feet still caused them to be in awe. When Moses wanted to see God, he was only allowed to see God's back in Exodus 33. Isaiah had a vision of God, describing in Isaiah 6 how he saw God seated on a throne with seraphs above Him. How-

ever, I do not believe that Isaiah saw the full power and glory of God. While some people in the Bible certainly saw God, no one ever saw the fullness of God.

So what does it mean to "see God?" Can we see Him today? We may not see God face to face, but I know we definitely see Him in many places. I certainly saw Him in the children and leaders of our SCUBA Vacation Bible School a few weeks ago. I saw Him in our confirmation students as they professed their faith in Jesus last month. I see Him in the care that many of you give to our members who are experiencing some challenging health issues. I see Him in the teachers of our Open Arms center in the love they show to children every day. I see Him in the Bible as God reveals Himself to us. I see Him in worship and prayer as He speaks to us. I see Him in Baptism, where God claims us as His children, and I see Him in Communion as we receive Jesus' body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins. God is revealed to us in many ways and it is exciting to see Him with eyes of faith and to live in His presence.
