Even though that command from God did not make any sense, Abraham tied up Isaac and was prepared to kill him, but God stopped him knowing that Abraham’s love for Him was greater than his love for his son. Job lost his 10 children, along with thousands of sheep, camels, and oxen, in one day, but through it all he continued to put his faith in God. Paul

was beaten, stoned, and shipwrecked, however he viewed his suffering as a gift and was anxious to serve God.
